Special Report on Girls Passing Class V Exam in 2010





This issue of IIMPACT's quarterly report gives you some marvelous news. A total of 368 girls have passed their Class V exams from IIMPACT Learning Centers.

For the first time, this year 163 girls have passed from centers in Mehmoodabad, a new area where we started the project in 2006. To our **amazement**, all have obtained first division marks.

We proudly credit the results to untiring efforts put in by the girls and teachers associated with the learning centers. The girls worked really hard, the teachers worked overtime to help and guide the girls, the supervisors were on their toes giving additional support, the mothers gave nutritious food to the girls before and during the exams and above all the community was proud of the fact that their girls would definitely do well. And yes! There is an air of happiness and pride in all the areas where IIMPACT works.

Despite all hardships and hurdles, IIMPACT girls have achieved the ultimate. In March 2010, total 368 girls had appeared in Class V Exams, 205 girls from Alwar and 163 from Mehmoodabad. 354 girls have obtained first division while just 14 got second division.


Almost all these girls are first generation learners and have never been to school, barring a few who are drop outs from Primary Classes. All credit for their good performance goes to IIMPACT's high quality primary education delivered through the Learning Centers.

IIMPACT uses specialized curriculum and very effective pedagogy from Class I to IV which brings a marked change in the skills and competencies of the girls. Once the girls complete their Class IV they undergo rigorous preparation with the help of teachers as they follow the Class V government curriculum. As a result of this hard work they score good marks; overcoming all the hardships that come their way as they belong to the deprived and poor communities.





Bhuteri (right) is one of the first to pass Class V from IIMPACT. She has cleared Class X this year and wants to study. Her parents cannot afford to educate her now, as they are poor and have seven children. She is very clear that she wants to study further atleast till Class XII and not get married at this young age. One of our benevolent donors has offered to support her higher education.

IIMPACT's main thrust is on preparing girls well at primary stages and make them pass Class V with good marks. In the last five years total 779 girls have succeeded in this. Today about 90% of those who passed are still going to schools. This is because their foundations have become strong.

EVIDENCE OF CHANGE - STUDY IN HARYANA AND RAJASTHAN
