Dear Friends

Every year the class 5 results are declared in the month of June. This year, we are once again made proud by our girls! They have performed extremely well in the exams and have set a hallmark for others to follow. Our topper scored a 98.2% followed closely by our second ranker at 98.1%! It is truly heartening to see so many girls score above 80%. The results are getting better every year! What else could we have wished for?

The girls who have graduated from the IIMPACT learning centers are first generation learners. Despite the difficult circumstances they face, for example, a one room thatched house with no electricity, looking after their siblings, going to fetch water every morning, washing clothes, utensils and at times cooking food for the whole family—they still have time to study and obtain as high as 90 percent and above. This is an incredible achievement. The girls are now eagerly looking forward to the felicitation ceremonies which will be held in different hubs in the month of July.

Our teachers play an extremely important role in helping the girls achieve such results. Training of our very able teachers to refresh and enhance their skills has enabled them to impart quality education and hence the girls also score so well. We at IIMPACT realize the importance of constantly providing training to them and are indeed grateful to them for making our mission possible at each step. The trainings are held every three months in different hubs of our project. Approximately, 30-40 teachers participate in every training session.

We take this opportunity to thank our donors for their valuable contribution towards educating the girl child. Your joining hands with us, giving us continued support and sponsoring learning centres has enabled us to bring more and more out of school girls in the IIMPACT learning centres. Our girls must expect no less. And you have given them a gift that no one can take away from them—the gift of education.

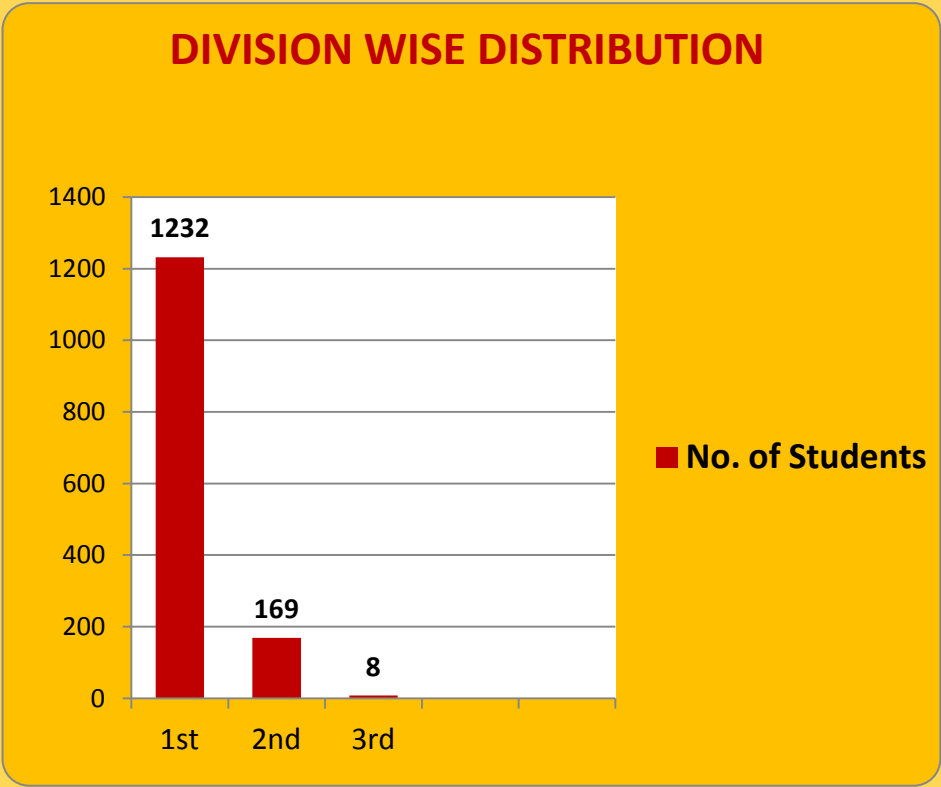

Yet again, this year, we have achieved 100% results! The girls have performed brilliantly making us extremely proud!

This year's Class 5 board exam results only prove that IIMPACT girls are doing well in studies and advancing in their class appropriately.

As covered in the last quarterly report, the past couple of months have been full of activity, for the girls, teachers and us. The girls were busy preparing for the exams and the teachers were helping the girls in their preparations. The exam months were one of anticipation and hope. The girls were a confident bunch during the exams. It was the teachers and the rest of us who were nervous for them, just like any parent is worried during their child's exams.

The girls would enter the exam hall, of course a little nervous—this is the first big exam of their lives (!) but would come out smiling. A paper well done! There is nothing else more satisfying than that confident smile on the faces of our girls. Following the exam results, the girl and her family will be assisted in admissions into the nearest government schools. In the following pages, we share with you the short interactions we had with some of our students from this batch. They talked about their life at IIMPACT, how they prepared for their exams and their future goals.

Photos of some girls who have scored amongst the highest are also given here.

In a recent survey on education, the findings revealed that the proportion of class 5 students able to read a class 2 level text has dropped from 53.7% in 2010 to 48.2% in 2011. However, we are proud to state here that all of our girls who are in class 5 can read and write well and solve mathematical problems of the expected level.

THE GIRLS TELL US ABOUT THEIR EXPERIENCE!

Name: Shakunat



मेरा नाम शकुनत है। मेरे पिताजी का नाम जाकिर हुसैन और मेरी माता जी का नाम निजरबी है। मैं गाँव चोर बसई में रहती हूँ। मैंने इस वर्ष कक्षा 5 की परीक्षा इब्तिदा तालीमशाला से पास की है। कक्षा 5 में मेरे अच्छे नम्बर आए हैं। अब सरकारी स्कूल में कक्षा 6 में दाखिला ले लिया है। अब मैं तालीमशाला के अपने अनुभव लिख रही हूँ।

तालीमशाला में हमें गुरुजी गोल घेरे में बिठाते थे। हमारे गुरुजी ने हमें कभी नहीं पीटा वह हमें डराते धमकाते भी नहीं थे। मेरी एक बहन इंगलिशा भी इस तालीमशाला से कक्षा 5 पास कर के

अब कक्षा 7 में सरकारी स्कूल में पढ़ रही है। हमारी तालीमशाला में बहुत अच्छी पढ़ाई होती है। हमारे गुरुजी हमें बहुत अच्छी – अच्छी बातें बताते थे। वह हमसे पूछते कि तुम क्यों पढ़ना चाहते हो तो हम चुप बैठ जाते थे। वह हमें बताते थे कि कोई भी काम करने के लिये पढ़ाई की जरूरत होती है। पढ़ लिखकर लड़कियाँ भी कुछ बन सकती हैं मुझे पता लगा कि जो काम लड़के कर सकते हैं वो काम लड़कियाँ भी कर सकती हैं। मैं भी पढ़ लिखकर पुलिस बनना चाहती हूँ।

हमारे गुरुजी का पढ़ाने का तरीका बहुत अच्छा था। वह कभी कहानी सुनाता, कभी खेल खेल में पढ़ाता, कभी बाहर घुमाने ले जाता, कभी कम्प्यूटर से पढ़ाता तो कभी प्रयोग करवाता। मुझे कम्प्यूटर चलाना बहुत अच्छा लगता है।

[My name is Shakunat. My father's name is Zakhir Hussain and my mother's name is Nijarbi. I stay in Village Chor Basai. I have passed class 5 with good marks. I have now taken admission into class 6 in a government school. I am writing about my experience at the IIMPACT learning center.

In the Center, guruji (many girls use this to refer to their teacher) would make us sit in a circle. He would never scold us or scare us. My elder sister Inglisha has also passed out from this center and is currently studying in the government school in class 7. Learning was fun in our center. Guruji would teach us many interesting things. Sometimes, he would ask us why we wanted to study. We would remain quiet at his question and then he explained to us that to do any kind of work it was important to be educated. He told us that even girls can become something if they are educated. I got to know that what men can do even women can. I want to study and become a police woman.

I really liked the way guruji taught us. He would tell us stories, teach us using play methods, sometimes he took us out of the class, sometimes he used the computer to teach. I really enjoy working on the computer.]

मुझे तालीमशाला बहुत अच्छी लगी। मुझे मेरी तालीमशाला हमेशा याद रहेगी। मैं आगे भी पढ़ाई करूंगी और पढ़ लिखकर डाक्टर बनूंगी।

[When the IIMPACT Learning center started in our village, everyone was very happy. My father enrolled me here and I started coming to the center. In the beginning, I found the teaching different here but slowly I started understanding. Initially the sir who was teaching us was replaced by another teacher, Suresh Ji .He also taught us well. In Math, counting, tables, addition, multiplication, fractions and lots of other things were taught. In Hindi and English we learnt reading and in science we learnt a lot of new things.

Sir used to test our understanding occasionally. After the class 4 evaluation he told us that we had to start preparing for the class 5 exam. For the preparations both sir and us worked really hard. Sir would take some extra classes after school. After going home also we would study for about 1-2 hours. Our efforts paid off as I scored good marks in the exam.

I really liked my Learning Center and will always remember it. I will study further and become a doctor.]

मेरा नाम खुशबू है। पहले मैं किसी दूसरे विद्यालय में पढ़ती थी। वहाँ मैंने दो वर्ष तक पढ़ाई की। वहाँ की पढ़ाई मुझे पसंद नहीं आई। क्योंकि वहाँ पर मैडम कम पढ़ाती हैं और आपस में बातचीत करती हैं। मोबाईल पर भी बातचीत करती हैं। उन्हें कुछ बोलते हैं तो मारती हैं। इस पिटाई के कारण मैंने अपना नाम तालीमशाला में लिखवा लिया। जिसमें मुकेश सर जी पढ़ाता था। जब पहले दिन मैं तालीमशाला गई तो मुझे अजीब सा माहौल लगा सभी बच्चे मस्ती से पढ़ रहे थे। सरजी भी बच्चों के साथ नीचे ही पढ़ा रहा था। मेरा मन भी बोलने को हो रहा था। पर मैं शर्म के कारण सरजी व बच्चों से नहीं

बोलती थी। सरजी ने मुझे बुलवाने का काफी प्रयास किया, कभी मुझसे अकेले में बातें करते, कभी मुझसे सामान मंगाते। और इस प्रकार धीरे धीरे मेरी शर्म हट गई और मैं मन लगाकर पढ़ने लगी। जो भी सरजी पढ़ाते मैं उसे ध्यान से सुनती और पढ़ती। इस प्रकार मैंने तालीमशाला से बहुत कुछ सीखा जैसे करोड़ तक के जोड़ – घटाव, गुणा भाग व हिन्दी पढ़ना, अंग्रेजी पढ़ना विभिन्न प्रकार के चित्र बनाना। और खेल भी सीखे।

इस प्रकार मैंने तालीमशाला में 3 वर्ष तक पढ़ाई की जिसमें मैंने कड़ी मेहनत करके कक्षा 5 में 85.43 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त किये। इसमें मेरी मेहनत के साथ साथ सरजी का भी बहुत योगदान है। इन्होंने मुझे बड़ी मेहनत से पढ़ाया और मैं जब घर रुक जाती तो पिताजी से बात करके स्कूल ले आते। इसी कारण मैंने यह सफलता प्राप्त की है।

[My name is Khushboo. I used to study in another school. I studied there for two years. I did not like it there. The teacher there taught less and would talk amongst themselves. They would talk on the phone too. Whenever we would say anything to them they would scold us. Because of this I got enrolled in the IIMPACT Learning center. On the first day at the center, I found the environment very different. All the children seemed to be enjoying while studying Sir, was also sitting on the floor with the children. I felt like talking with my friends and sir, but was shy to do so. Sir tried a lot to make me talk. He would talk to me separately or would ask me to do some chore. This way I slowly overcame my shyness and started studying wholeheartedly. I learnt a lot at the center like addition up to a crore, subtraction, multiplication, Hindi and English. We also learnt many games.

This way I studied at the center for 3 years, worked hard and attained good marks in the class 5 exams. Along with my hard work, my sir also contributed a lot and worked very hard. Whenever I would stay at home for some other work, he would talk to my father, convince him and take me to school. It is because of this that I have achieved success today.

Want to study till college and it is my dream to become a police officer. I would like to advise other girls to work hard and get good marks.]

I am Ruchi Singh and I belong to a very poor family. I live in Terwa Manikapur .I have passed class V from the IIMPACT- Nalanda learning center at Terwa Manikapur with good marks.

I'm very happy that I have done well in these exams. My Madam helps me during my studies. She helped me a lot with preparing for these exams. I am no longer afraid of school or learning.

I like to read Hindi, English and also like drawing. As and when I would have a problem or question I would ask my Madam again and again till I understood it completely. This makes me feel very comfortable in the Center.

My determination is getting stronger each day and I am working very hard to achieve my goal of becoming a teacher when I grow up.

BHUTERI: A SUCCESS STORY



Bhuteri, a girl who has managed to cross all barriers of poverty, social norms and gender bias is an IIMPACT girl. And we are proud of her!

Her achievement? Bhuteri has attained a 1st division in the class 12 board exams! [like many other girls who have graduated from the IIMPACT learning centers.] This news has brought joy to the IIMPACT team.

Her family comprises of her mother, father, 5 sisters and one brother. Before she joined IIMPACT she used to help out in the household chores. Washing utensils, clothes, cleaning the house and taking the buffaloes to graze in the fields were some of the things that she did. She used to watch other girls going to school and she would silently wish that she could go too. She went to a small *gurukul* at first and started liking studying. However, she could not continue for long at the *gurukul* due to financial problems. By that time IIMPACT had started its center at Bandipura, Alwar. She immediately enrolled at the center. She was a hard working, diligent student and always topped her class. She says that the time at the IIMPACT Learning center was a lot of fun and the learning, best that she has seen. In her preparations for the Class 5 exams and the 12th she did not stop doing her house work but continued helping out and doing her studies side by side. She says that she managed to study on her own as she could not afford to go for tuitions. After leaving IIMPACT she joined a private school. When asked about how education has changed her she said that by getting educated she has become more aware of the world around her. She feels empowered as she can now read and write. She helps her parents and brother wherever reading, writing and understanding is involved. She feels that she can now earn and add to the family income. Bhuteri has a good hand in tailoring. She gets numerous orders to stitch clothes for the village folk.

She wants to continue studying. This month she has filled the application for B.A. Her parents are not pressurizing her to get married which is a major shift from the typical attitude of parents in villages. We at IIMPACT will continue to guide her and help her choose a right path for herself.
